SUBJECT: Resolution to Vote for a Candidate for the Board of Directors of the

Brazoria County Appraisal District

BOARD POLICY: CCH (Legal)

DISTRICT GOAL: Brazosport ISD will exercise fiscal responsibility to ensure financial

strength and provide the resources to equip and maintain quality

facilities and educational programming.

FISCAL NOTE: N/A

Background Information:

• Section CCH (LEGAL) of the *Board of Trustees Policies* describes procedures relating to countywide appraisal districts. Section 6.03 of the *Texas Property Tax Code* requires the chief appraiser to calculate the number of votes to which each taxing unit is entitled, and deliver written notice of each unit's voting entitlement before October 1 of each odd-numbered year. Although this is not an odd-numbered year, the Board must adopt a resolution due to recent changes in state law affecting the composition of Appraisal District boards. Under the new legislation, Appraisal District boards are required to have nine members: one seat for the tax assessor-collector, five appointed members, and three members elected by voters. The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote must determine its vote by resolution and submit it to the chief appraiser before December 15. Each governing body in a county appraisal district that is entitled to vote may cast its votes for one candidate or distribute them among candidates for any number of directorships. The chief appraiser counts the votes, declares the five candidates receiving the largest cumulative vote totals elected, and submits the results before December 15 to the governing body of each taxing unit and to the candidates.

Administrative Considerations:

• Certification has been received from Marcel Pierel, Chief Appraiser of the Brazoria County Appraisal District, that Brazosport Independent School District is entitled to 992 votes for the five directors to be elected to the Board of Directors of the Brazoria County Appraisal District.

The Chief Appraiser has received nominations from each of the taxing units in the Appraisal District eligible to vote, and has prepared the attached Official Ballot listing all candidates nominated.
