 - The campus administration will focus on monitoring high-quality small group instruction in reading and math by ensuring teachers incorporate explicit and systematic targeted instruction as they provide their students with on-going feedback to guide their students' learning. This real-time feedback should empower the students to recognize their learning gaps and track their own formative and summative performance data overtime.
