⇒ If you want to be a volunteer, please sign up online at the Three Rivers School District website. If you have any questions, please contact us in the office and we'd be happy to assist you.

 $\Rightarrow$  If your child is missing a back pack, coat or any other item, please come look in the lost and found. The bins are overflowing.

⇒ The district is using a new company to produce and mail the attendance letters out. Please continue to call us if your child won't be in school for any reason and sending the notes if they are sick. We will need a Dr.'s note if the child is absent for five or more days. Even if a child's absences are excused the letters are still going out so all parents or guardians are aware of the absences. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us.

 $\Rightarrow$  Kids are not to be dropped off any earlier than 7:15 Monday-Thursday/ 8:15 on Fridays as we don't have staff scheduled to look after them earlier than that and that is when the cafeteria opens.

⇒ If you want your child to have any medication at school you will need to come into the office and fill out the appropriate paperwork. This applies to EVERYTHING, even cough drops.



## Child Find for Special Education

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age. The Three Rivers School District requests assistance with the identification of any disabled children ages Birth through 21 who are not enrolled or currently being served in one of the District's schools.

## The Josephine County Youth Foundation Awards Student Enrichment Grants

Evergreen teachers Mrs. Snyder (First grade), Ms. Keil (Life Skills) and Mrs. Campbell (Title 1 Intervention) received grants from the Josephine County Youth Foundation. These grants will directly enrich student learning, and provide literacy engagement with families.

Mrs. Snyder received funds to purchase an online program called RAZ-Kids for her classroom. It will give her students access to a leveled collection of books for their independent reading time. They will be able to listen to the stories, read them on their own, then take quizzes on them. The children are very excited about this new program!

Ms. Keil received funds to purchase social skills curriculum, materials, and resources. Students who have a strong foundation in social behavior or social skills, are more successful with problem-solving, decision making, self-management, and have the ability to initiate and maintain positive social relationships with others. This is a very exciting opportunity that will encourage all students at our school to soar to success!

Mrs. Campbell received funds for the BEAR (Building Early Academic Readiness) Program. Books will be purchased for this family/home literacy program. I've had the sniffles for more than a week, and they aren't getting better.

I still have asthma symptoms after using my asthma medicine (and call 911 if I'm having trouble breathing after using an inhaler).
