These candidates' skills and qualifications based on work history, training, and expertise in the Iñupiaq language and culture merit the Type M teacher certificate.

Background:

The North Slope Borough School District has offered contracts to all five individuals as the Iñupiaq Language Teachers of the aboveforementioned sites/grade levels for the 2022 – 2023 school year. Both Kathy Bodfish and Jaime Patkotak are returning ilisaurrit and are seeking a renewal for their certifications. Martha Pausanna, JaeJae Ningeok, Vernon Elavgak, and Misty

Plymale are all first-year ilisaurrit and are seeking their initial certifications. Prior Board approval is required by the Alaska Department of Education in addition to other specified requirements in order for teachers to be granted Type M certificates.
