IReady Dyslexia Screener

INITIAL DYSLEXIA SCREENING

GRADES K-2

iReady serves as the **initial dyslexia screener** for all students in K-2

Screening is administered at the beginning of the year to identify students who may be at risk for dyslexia, allowing for early intervention and support.

GRADE 7

iReady is also used as the **dyslexia screener for 7th grade** students.

This screening ensures that students who may have been previously unidentified receive appropriate evaluation and services at the secondary level.

SISD has transitioned to IReady consumable materials as the primary mathematics resource for Kindergarten through 5th grade. Teachers began professional learning on March 13th to prepare for full implementation in 2026–27.

Grades 6–8 will adopt McGraw Hill as their primary mathematics resource. While this curriculum includes an online platform, instruction will be delivered primarily hands-on to maximize student engagement and deep conceptual understanding.
