- Low Attendance Days Waiver: The Low Attendance Days Waiver proves districts or campuses to excuse any instructional days from ADA and FSP funding calculations that have attendance at least 10 percentage points below the last school year's overall average attendance due to inclement weather, health, or safety-related issues.
- Missed School Days Waiver: The Missed School Days Waiver provides districts or campuses for excused absences if instructional days are missed due to inclement weather, health, safetyrelated, or other issues.
