AGENDA ITEM: 2018-2019 District Instructional Focus Update

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The development of an instructional data dashboard will provide the district with a systematic process for gathering multiple data points to track implementation levels of the district focus areas and to monitor student progress data throughout the school year.
- At the conclusion of the 2018-2019 school year, the Bearcat Leadership Team analyzed district implementation data for the school year and celebrated progress toward the district goals.
- The four indicators that were measured and analyzed included:
 - We Will / I Will (goal of 100%): At the end of the school year, 98% of classrooms had evidence of the learning target (4% increase from beginning of school year).
 - Thinking Maps with the Frame/ TM Taken to Writing (goal of 80%): At the end of the school year, 80% of classrooms had evidence of Thinking Maps with the Frame and Thinking Maps Taken to Writing (27% increase from the beginning of school year).
 - <u>Critical Writing (goal of 100%):</u> At the end of the school year, 89% of classrooms had evidence of daily critical writing. (30% increase from the beginning of the school year).
 - Frequent Small-Group Purposeful Talk (goal of 100%): At the end of the school year, 98% of classrooms had evidence of frequent small-group purposeful talk (18% increase from the beginning of the school year).
