District Goal 1 Objective 1: Improve TAKS scores in Math: Focus on at risk students who are currently failing the Math State Assessments.				
Activity 1: Mentor Program: AC Jones staff will be assigned a small group of students who they will mentor and monitor in Math. Staff will meet with each mentee at least 3 times per week and be involved in their behavior, grades, attendance, etc.	October 21-May 31	At risk students who have difficulty in Math will develop a sense of trust with their mentor. The mentor will serve as a support system for the student who need support the most. Teachers will be responsible for working with these students to help build their self confidence as well as help with student skills and test taking strategies. Activity 2: CBC/ACJ Math Intervention Class: AC Jones in partnership with the administration and staff at CBC has developed a pilot Math Intervention course that has been built into the Master schedule. This class targets those students who are at risk of failing their Math state assessment.	August 22-May 31	Within this class, there are several components that are built into the week's curriculum. The student will be getting addition help in math skills that will help them close the gap between their grade level and their ability level. In addition to the supplemental math assistance, these students will also be getting assistance in study skills, as well as test taking strategies. This class is offered to incoming freshman (a few sophomores) and all the students who have not passed the EXIT level state assessment in Math.
