

RELATIONS WITH PARENT ORGANIZATIONS

(LOCAL)

District-affiliated school-support organizations and booster organizations, and other parent groups, shall organize, fundraise or solicit donations, and function in a way that is consistent with the District's philosophy and objectives, Board policies, District administrative regulations, applicable UIL or other governing association guidelines, and financial and audit regulations. [See also CDC and CFC]

Before engaging in fundraising or soliciting gifts, an organization or group shall notify the principal or other appropriate administrator identified in administrative regulations. [See CDC(LOCAL) for District acceptance of gifts and solicitations]

**Use of District
Facilities**

District-affiliated school-support or booster organizations may use District facilities with prior approval of the appropriate administrator. Other parent groups may use District facilities in accordance with policy GKD.

Standards for
Interaction with
Students and Use of
Facilities

Parent organizations, including parent-teacher associations, booster clubs, and similar groups, when operating on District property or at District-sponsored events, shall comply with all Board policies governing conduct, communication, and use of facilities.

Such organizations shall not use access to students, instructional spaces, or school-sponsored platforms to promote personal political, religious, or ideological viewpoints that are not directly related to an approved educational purpose.

All materials, displays, and communications directed toward students shall support the educational mission of the District and the intended purpose of the activity and shall comply with applicable Board policy, including EMB (Local) and FNA (Legal), as appropriate.

The Superintendent or designee shall have authority to regulate such activities and require modification or removal of materials or communications that do not align with these standards.

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
