News & Notes:

- Summer Programming is in full swing!
 - o Ranger Ride: full at 50 registrants. (This is a free offering and always fills up quickly.)
 - <u>Camp Cuyuna</u>: Currently 9 students registered for this new mountain biking skills camp that will be held in mid-July.
 - o Boys' Basketball Camp: Held June 5th 9th and had 59 participants in 3rd 9th grades.
 - o Girls' Basketball Camp: Coming up June 26th 29th and currently has 34 registered.
 - Youth Baseball: Multiple programs serving ages Preschool 6th grade and has 143 students registered. Thank you to Cuyuna Range Youth Baseball for coordinating these programs!
 - Youth Softball: 40 girls are registered for 14U, 12U and 10U teams.
