

Bylaws of the Board

Construction of the Agenda

The Superintendent in cooperation with the Chairperson of the Board of Education shall prepare an agenda for each regular meeting. Three members of the Board of Education may call the Superintendent and request any item to be placed on the agenda no later than 72 hours prior to the legally required public posting of the agenda. If three or more members request an item be placed on the agenda, the Superintendent shall place the item on the agenda.

Actions by the Board

No action will be taken unless the subject acted upon was listed in the agenda published for that meeting. However, in exigent circumstances, an item of business not included on the agenda of a regular meeting may be considered and/or acted upon after a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting to add such business to the agenda.
