CLASS SIZE GUIDELINE

The Board of Education believes that class size should maximize students' educational experience by providing quality instruction, an appropriate learning environment and attention.

The following class size ranges are not absolute numbers but are to be used as a guide by the district administration along with other variables to determine when a class section should be eliminated or an additional class section added.

Class sizes and staffing are set at the time the preliminary budget for the following school year is set by the Board. This typically takes place in May or June. Staffing will be added only if actual enrollment exceeds projections by 10% or more.

- Class size guidelines do not apply to special education classes, academic support, advanced classes such as AP, and courses limited by supplies and safety requirements.
