Self-Evaluation

The New Fairfield Board of Education is comprised of duly elected individuals to oversee the Public Schools of the community. This very responsible and complex job requires that the Board blend its diverse opinion into a common purpose which will give direction to the school system. The local community looks to its Board of Education to provide leadership for the school system. The success of the system depends on how well that role is carried out.

Therefore, it shall be the policy of the New Fairfield Board of Education that there shall be an annual program of self evaluation in which each member shall participate.

Policy Review and Evaluation

The Board shall follow through the policies it has formulated. The Board recognizes that policy review is an important and ongoing process, and to this end the Board shall rely on the school staff, students, and the community to provide evidence of the effect of the policies which it has adopted.
