Subject: Middle of Year Progress Monitoring Data

Background Information

Midway ISD tracks student growth through multiple assessment tools: NWEA MAP, Tango LION, and IXL. These assessments provide individual student progress data for the Beginning of Year, Middle of Year, and End of Year. Additionally, we assess student growth and intervention needs using ongoing unit tests and an early spring District Benchmark Assessment.

NWEA MAP Growth, used as the district's K-5 reading screener, is a nationally normed, adaptive test that determines a student's current achievement level through a metric called the RiT score. Tango LION, the district math screener for K-5, measures individual student mastery of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills throughout the year and reports whether a student is meeting grade-level expectations based on the current content covered. Beginning in the 2025-2026 school year, we started using IXL as our comprehensive, adaptive math and reading assessment for students in grades 6 – 9 Math and 6-10 RLA. In addition to being a web-based adaptive assessment, IXL provides students with targeted practice and skill recommendations to address knowledge gaps and helps teachers monitor progress and make informed instructional decisions using formative data. The midyear progress of student growth data will be presented tonight.

In addition to the MOY screener data, we will use Benchmark Assessments in the coming weeks to identify student strengths and areas for growth as we approach state testing beginning on April 8, 2026. Dr. Odajima will present the data captured to date and the plans for data-informed decisions moving forward.
