

To what extent, if at all, does the current structure of the RMS schedule allow you adequate time to meet with students for related services?







To what extent, if at all, does the current structure of the RMS schedule allow you adequate time to successfully manage your current caseload?




To what extent, if at all, does the current structure of the RMS schedule allow you adequate time to complete your professional responsibilities other than student check-ins?



To what extent, if at all, does the current structure of the RMS schedule allow you adequate time to meet and colloborate with colleagues?




To what extent, if at all, does the current structure of the RMS schedule support a student's social-emotional well-being?
