Dr. Coleman asked how many students we will be able to accommodate for Summer School. Dr. Roberts stated we are awaiting NWEA test scores, once this information is available we should be able to finalize the number of students we are targeting.

Dr. Coleman told the Community that was listening if your child needs Summer School please call the designated school.
