U.S. News & World Report Recognizes Millsap Middle School Among the 2025 Best Middle Schools

Washington, D.C. – January 2026 – **Millsap Middle School has been ranked No. 335 in Texas, among the 2026 Best Middle School rankings by U.S. News & World Report.**

The rankings include more than 79,000 public elementary and middle schools across the country.

Schools are ranked at the state and district level, with Best Charter Schools ranked as a stand-alone category.

Millsap Middle placed #335 statewide out of 1890 schools ranked in Texas.
