The Transportation Department would like to recognized Three students from Robert E. Lee Elementary in competing for Texas Association of Pupil Transportation (TAPT) Poster Contest.

On January at the Principals Meeting the announcement was made on TAPT Poster Contest where student can earn up to \$250 1st prize, \$100 2nd prize, or \$50 3rd prize for the school bus poster contest. Robert E. Lee submitted 25 posters to the Transportation Department. The posters were reviewed by the Transportation Staff and the top three posters from each category were selected to compete at the Centex Local chapter on April 10, 2019. There are five divisions for students to compete based on Grade Level:
