Career & Tech



The new 916 program is a last resort for students so they can get the help they need to return to the classroom as soon as possible.

New innovative 916 program

A very small percentage of students who are not successful in 916's regular programs will be temporarily referred to the integrated mental health program until they are stabilized.

A few students are not successful with Tier 1 and Tier 2 services alone. These students continue to receive those services, **and** also receive Tier 3 services. Our goal is to intervene early in order to prevent placement in a more restrictive setting.

Conge the student can stabilize with help from a doctor, they return to 916, where they receive Tier 1, 2 and 3 services. We do everything we can to prevent them from needing to return to the integrated mental health program.
