has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the MANOR ISD POLICE DEPARTMENT from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the MANOR ISD POLICE DEPARTMENT if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the MANOR ISD POLICE DEPARTMENT has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the MANOR ISD POLICE DEPARTMENT who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the MANOR ISD POLICE DEPARTMENT
- 6) requires collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - a. the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - b. whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search;

- c. whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual;
- d. whether the peace officer used physical force that resulted in bodily injury during the stop;
- e. the location of the stop;
- f. the reason for the stop.

7) requires the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:

- a. the Commission on Law Enforcement; and
- b. the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT MAY INFLUENCE AND/OR IMPACT DATA REPORTED:**

The demographic data for the City of Manor was collected based on gender and ethnicity percentages within the city's population. However, it is important to note that traffic stops conducted in Manor do not solely involve the city's residents. Due to the high volume of commuters passing through the city daily, many of these stops involve non-residents traveling in and around Manor. As a result, the report reflects traffic stops conducted on both Manor citizens and commuters. This distinction is significant as it highlights that the data is influenced by the transient nature of commuter traffic, rather than providing a representation of traffic stops exclusively among Manor residents. Such a dynamic underscores the complexity of analyzing traffic stop data in a city that serves as a thoroughfare for many drivers who may not be part of the local demographic profile.

This form is produced in accordance with the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Article 2.134 as required by the Texas Occupation Code Section 1701.164 and the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement. The Agency Service Area Demographics data was derived from available public data sources such as the US Census Bureau and other statistical services available to the reporting agency.
