

Approval for Travel to a Non-State-Sanctioned Activity, Out-of-State GHS Choir

SUMMARY:

- This item requests approval of a request by the Guyer High School Varsity Choir for travel to the Red River Sing-Off High School Choral Festival in Durant, Oklahoma, October 16, 2012.
