DIRECTORY INFORMATION**

Directory information means those items of personally identifiable information contained in a student education record which is not generally considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released. The following categories are designated as directory information. The following directory information may be released to the public through appropriate procedures:

- •—1. Student's name;
- 2. Student's address;
- •— 3. Student's telephone listing;
- 4, Student's electronic address;
- 5. Student's photograph;
- 6. Date and place of birth;
- 7. Major field of study;
- 8. Participation in officially recognized sports and activities;
- 9. Weight and height of athletic team members;
- **10.** Dates of attendance;
- 11. Degrees or awards received;
- 12. Most recent previous school or program attended.

Public Notice

MESD **will shall** give annual public notice to parents of students in attendance and students 18 years of age or emancipated. The notice shall identify the types of information considered to be directory information and MESD's option to release such information **and the requirement that the MESD must shall**, by law, release secondary students' names, addresses and telephone numbers to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education, unless parents or eligible students requires the MESD withhold this information. Such notice will shall be given prior to release of directory information.

Exclusions

Exclusions from any or all directory categories named as directory information **or release of information to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education must shall be submitted in writing to MESD by the parent, student 18 years of age or emancipated student within 15 days of annual public notice.**

Directory information shall be released only with Superintendent or designee approval.

Directory information considered by MESD to be detrimental will-shall not be released.

Information will shall not be given over the telephone except in health and safety emergencies.

At no time will shall a student's Social Security number or student identification number be considered directory information.

END OF POLICY

**As used in this policy, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 125.005 (4) and 125.300 – 125.325. The determination of whether an individual is acting in a parental relationship, for purposes of determining residency, depends on the evaluation of the factors listed in ORS 419B.373. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 109.056.
