

WorkKeys Data



- □ 5,169 individual tests administered in the fall window.
- ☐ 19,084 individual tests administered in the spring window.
- ☐ Approximately 75% of students that tested earned a NCRC.
 - 6,098 Total Certificates
 Earned
 - □ 726 Platinum
 - **□ 1,205** Gold
 - **□ 2,148** Silver
 - **□ 2,019** Bronze

- ☐ Total Schools Tested
 - □ **184** of 306 (**60%**)
- 86% of schools that earned a NCRC utilized the WorkKeys curriculum
- ☐ Compared to 2021, there were **126 more** high schools that had students earning NCRCs in 2022.



Work Ready Communities




- ☐ Work Ready Communities (WRC) strengthen partnership between school districts and industries.

 - □ Drew, Jefferson, and Scott counties have become a certified WRC
 - Nevada county began participating in WRC
 - Johnson, Little River, and Montgomery counties have completed WRC Boot Camp and are progressing towards their participation in WRC
