Students with Disabilities

Students ages kindergarten through students who have not had their 22nd birthday on or before the 1st day of school for students living in the district who have been evaluated by qualified educational and/or medical personnel and found eligible for services or programs for students with disabilities shall be provided a free and appropriate public education. The district will determine whether a student is both eligible for and in need of special education services.

Special education and related services will be provided to meet the needs of each student with disabilities as specified in that student's individualized education program (IEP).

The Board directs the superintendent to ensure procedures for the implementation of special education services and programs are developed by the district or through agreements with the Umatilla-Morrow ESD and conform with the requirements of state and federal legislation. Such procedures will be retained in handbook form a document titled Special Education Procedures for the Morrow County School District, consistent with the procedures as approved by, and on file with, the Oregon Department of Education.
