## TITLE IX SURVEY

Annually students are surveyed on their participation and interest in sports.

In the past, students expressed significant interest in lacrosse, girls wrestling, and boys' volleyball, which resulted in the district adding these sports.

The district anticipates UHSAA sanctioning Esports for the 2025-2026 SY and the district anticipates seeking board approval to add this sport.

This year the highest areas of student interest were in volleyball, track & field, and skiing.

Next year the district will push the survey out during advisory to increase student participation and ensure the district is meeting our students' needs and interests.

Fewer students than last year said cost was a barrier to participation. The majority of students who are not participating in athletics indicated it was because they had no interest or had after school conflicts.



# HIGHLIGHTS

Some differences in cost per program/athletes are due to:

- Travel, camps, clinics
- Longer seasons and going to state tournaments
- Different types of gear and equipment

The district allows equitable opportunities for all teams to fundraise, travel, etc.

The district will examine whether it can reduce some athletic fees due to consistent lower spending.

The new West High School clinic completed 162 physicals for athletes.
