Background Information: In 1962, President John F. Kennedy signed a joint proclamation by Congress designating the second full week of October to be National School Lunch Week. The National School Lunch Program was created in 1946 to provide nutritious meals to children from low-income families who might not otherwise have access to a daily meal. The program ensures the health and well-being of all public school students, boosts academic performance by giving students the fuel they need to succeed, and closes the opportunity gap for children across the country. National School Lunch Week provides an opportunity for School Nutrition Association members and students around the country to celebrate in their cafeterias with decorations, special menus, and events. The National School Lunch Program serves approximately 30 million children every school day. This year's campaign theme is *Taste the World: Your School Lunch Passport!*
