

Lakeview Schools Diabetic Management Protocol

Created: 5/3/2022

When diabetic students may attend school:

- Blood glucose readings are at or below 300. (If student arrives at school with blood sugar at or above 300 and the student's blood sugar comes down within 30 minutes of arrival, they may stay in school.) Students may come to school at any point in the day once their blood sugars are at or below 300.
- All diabetic supplies are present in the health office which may, include but is not limited to: glucose test strips, glucometer, lancets, alcohol wipes, all supplies needed for insulin pump (if applicable), extra insulin, snacks, glucose tabs, insulin needles, and ketone test strips.
- All doctors orders are received by the health office and up to date for diabetic
 management at school. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform
 the primary diabetes care provider that the Lakeview Health Office needs copies
 of all diabetic orders for the student before the student starts attending school at
 Lakeview. The health office will also assist in requesting orders as needed
 throughout the school year.

When diabetic students must stay home from school:

- Blood glucose readings are 301 or greater. May return to school at any point in the day once blood sugars are at or below 300. (If student arrives at school with blood sugar at or above 300 and the student's blood sugar comes down within 30 minutes of arrival, they may stay in school.)
- Student is experiencing DKA (diabetic ketoacidosis).

- Student does not have all diabetic supplies listed above needed to manage diabetes while at school. May return to school once all supplies are provided to health office.
- Doctors orders are not yet received by the health office or are not up to date. It is
 the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform the primary diabetes care
 provider that the Lakeview Health Office needs copies of all diabetic orders for
 the student before the student starts attending school at Lakeview. The health
 office will also assist in requesting orders as needed throughout the school year.

Field Trips:

- Student must have all supplies needed to manage diabetes packed to bring along on field trips. Student will not be allowed on field trips if supplies are not provided.
- If student is bringing their own lunch (not provided by the school), the student/guardian must provide carb counts for all food items and include in lunch bag.
- Parent/guardian's are welcomed to attend field trips to assist students with diabetic management.
- If parent/guardian is not able to attend field trip, a staff member who is chaperoning the field trip will be appointed and trained by the school nurse and/or parent/guardian on basic diabetic management of student.
