Overview:

AP Seminar is an innovative, college-level course designed to develop students' ability to analyze, evaluate, and communicate complex ideas effectively. This foundational course fosters critical thinking, research skills, and collaboration essential competencies for success in college and careers. Districts must have board approval to implement innovative courses. The course will satisfy elective credit toward graduation requirements.

Key Benefits:

- Prepares Students for College & Career Success: Enhances students' ability to research, synthesize • information, and construct evidence-based arguments.
- Cross-Curricular Learning: Encourages interdisciplinary thinking by engaging students in real-world and • academic issues through multiple perspectives.
- Develops Essential 21st-Century Skills: Strengthens students' analytical reasoning, collaboration, and communication abilities, aligning with workforce demands.
- Increased Passing Rates on AP Exams: College Board reports that students who take AP Seminar are more likely to achieve a passing score on subsequent AP courses compared with students who have not completed AP Seminar.

Recommendation

Move to approve AP Seminar for the 2025-2026 school year to expand rigorous academic opportunities for students, strengthen college and career readiness, and enhance interdisciplinary learning.
