	<p>2023 Legislation Updates</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Personal Finance Government & Citizenship Algebra 2 READ ACT <p>Phase 1 PD Summary</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students who begin grade 9 in the 2024-25 school year and later must successfully complete a course for credit in personal finance in grade 10, 11, or 12. A teacher of a personal finance course that satisfies the graduation requirement must have a field license or out-of-field permission in agricultural education, business, family and consumer science, social studies, or math. Students beginning grade 9 in the 2024-2025 school year and later must complete a course in government and citizenship in either grade 11 or 12 or an advanced placement, international baccalaureate, or other rigorous course on government and citizenship Algebra II, Integrated Mathematics III, or an equivalent in high school as defined by the high school math standards (Alg II no longer required as a course, but students must meet all HS math standards within the 3 course sequence). <p>Professional Development Requirements in The READ Act</p> <p>Beginning July 1, 2024, each district must provide teachers and instructional support staff with responsibility for teaching reading with training on evidence-based reading instruction that is approved by the Department of Education.</p> <p>District staff required to complete approved professional development include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> intervention teachers working with students in grades K-12; all classroom teachers of students in kindergarten through grade three and children in prekindergarten programs; special education teachers; curriculum directors; instructional support staff who provide reading instruction; and employees who select literacy instructional materials for a district. <p>All other teachers and instructional staff required to receive training under the Read Act must complete the training no later than July 1, 2027.</p>
