These numbers will comply with district requirements of a 10 to 1 ratio of students to adult chaperones. All chaperones will be trained in school district policy regarding responsibilities and duties prior to the trip. All rules of conduct established

by the school district will be strictly enforced.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Performance tickets are valued at \$25 per person for

direct expenses. The total value of our tickets is approximately \$7,000. This expense, along transportation to the event, will be covered by The Hobby Center and ExxonMobil at no additional cost to Pasadena

ISD.
