Chair McBee called the regular board meeting to order at 6:00pm and welcomed guests. The group recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes

Minutes from the July 11, 2016 Board Meeting will be presented at the September meeting due to the Executive Board Secretary, Tami Calvert, being on extended medical leave.

Correspondence/Communications

The Board has received a Thank You note from Tami Calvert.

The Board Recognized Nicole Stewart for her dedicated work with Success 101/102 at Pendleton High School. She was recently recognized at the Los Angeles, California conference for her hard work in getting this program off the ground and running. She brought home a plaque recognizing Pendleton High School for "Sustaining Medal for 3 Years – In recognition of the effort required to achieve the status of Career Choices Silver Medal School and the ongoing effort necessary to sustain that level of excellence. Academic Innovations congratulates the faculty and staff of Pendleton High School for their dedication and service to the young people of their community". Since the inception of this program, this past graduating class of Pendleton High School earned approximately \$800,000.00 more in scholarships.

Reports

Superintendent Andy Kovach brought up his concern regarding the later start date for grades K-5 (September 19, 2016). The Instructional Hours are currently met, but if we have to cancel school (due to weather), we may fall short. Several options were discussed.

Superintendent Andy Kovach, Chair Debbie McBee and Dave Krumbein attended the OSBA Summer Conference, July 15-17, 2016 in Bend Oregon. They shared with the board a summary of the conference sessions.

Superintendent Kovach reported to the board the several meetings he has had the opportunity to attend this summer.

Pendleton Association of Teachers

Gary Humphries has met with Superintendent Kovach and Human Resources Director Bixler. Uniserv (Regional) is trying to plan trainings for professional development that could give credit or non-credit classes for teachers.

PL874/Indian Education Issues

Lloyd Commander had no report, but is looking forward to a good year.

IMESD Talking Points -

Superintendent Andy Kovach shared the IMESD talking points with the board.

Bond Update

Dave Fishel updated the board on the progress of bond projects across the district. All projects are currently on schedule and on budget. Sherwood and Washington school buildings are complete, site work is to be completed before the start of school on September 19. Lincoln Elementary is currently under renovation with the district office administration to move in September. Renovation to West Hills is currently under way with completion of the project December, 2016. The district will plan to move into that facility during the winter break.

The District Core team has been meeting to outline the remaining projects for the summer of 2017. With an estimated \$2.5 million remaining, the district will be able to complete the Priority I Projects, which include renovation of the High School Auditorium, High School track/football field upgrades and improvements to the lot across from the Pendleton Early Learning Center.

Blue Mountain Community College Pool

Dr. Fred Robinson, representative of the Pendleton Swim Association presented information to the board regarding the status of the BMCC pool. Dr. Robinson noted the importance of the pool to the PSA as well as to the high school in Pendleton and Hermiston. Dr. Robinson requested the support of the district regarding the reopening of the BMCC pool. Dave Krumbein stated that the board will take action on a resolution at the next meeting in support of PSA and BMCC's efforts to reopen/maintain the pool at the college.

Suggestions and Comments from Visitors

Gary Humphries (Pendleton Association of Teachers) recommends the Pendleton School Board to support Oregon Measure 97 (Corporation taxation above \$25 million), Oregon Measure 98 (CTE - we may use money), and Oregon Measure 99 (Outdoor School). Gary also inquired as to when teachers will have access to Sherwood and Washington Schools. There are no dates yet, but they will have extra in-service days. Teachers will need to remain flexible.

Superintendent Kovach recommended changing of the date of the September, 2016 Regular Board Meeting from Monday, September 12 to Monday, September 19 due to the Pendleton Round-Up Activities. Mr. Krumbein made the motion, Mr. Umbarger seconded, and approved unanimously by the board.
