Building Update

BMS staff (minus administrators, custodians and secretaries) continue work remotely due the continued shut down by the BTBC.

Portions of the "old" portion of the building (6th and 7th grade pods, BJA, library, nurse's station, specials and SPED on 2nd floor, and old offices) are 95% complete. The 8th grade pod is nearly complete sans the flooring on the treads in the commons area and paint touch-ups. BJA was completely repainted and will receive three new whiteboards, as well as updated crescent tables, chairs and teacher's desks. It is also waiting on new treads for both of their stairwells. The new addition is close to completion, and I was told it should be done soon. The new gym needs one more coat of sealant on the floor and three additional rows of seating of the bleachers installed. The cafeteria is complete, other than waxing/sealing the floor, which can't be done until the construction crew is gone. The new kitchen area is almost finished as well.

The building is still not 100% wifi capable, with only the old office area having connectivity.

Data

Academic rigor continues to increase, and staff have been submitting their percentages of attendance in their Google Meets, as well as the percentage of assignments turned in weekly.

Attendance and assignment numbers continue to slowly rise with 49.6% attendance in Google Meets, and 38.5% of assignments were turned in for the week of December 14th-18th.

Technology Update
