

- The opening of Braswell High School and the additional rezoning proposal will
  - Address the fastest growth rate in the district along the 380 corridor and
  - Relieve potential overcrowding at DHS and RHS, while balancing the number of students between the two high schools
  - Allow for long term planning based on district growth projections

# Rezoning Proposal Development


- O Collaboration for development of potential rezoning proposals includes:

  - Parents and community members in the affected attendance zones





- Will IB transportation continue for my child at DHS?
- Will there be transportation to the new school?
- What if my child would like to apply for a transfer?
