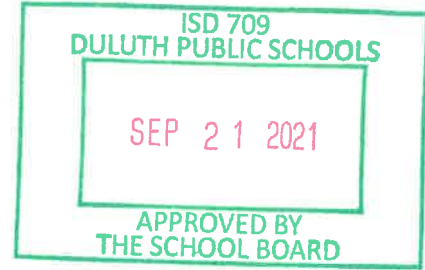

DEED OF GIFT

I. Transfer of Ownership
