RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MILITARY-CONNECTED STUDENTS AND FAMILIES

WHEREAS, the United Township school community has a long and distinguished record of military service and sacrifice, with generations of students, alumni, and family members who have served honorably in every branch of the United States Armed Forces;

WHEREAS, the District regularly enrolls students whose parents or guardians serve on active duty, in the Reserve, in the National Guard, or who are veterans, and recognizes the unique academic, social, and emotional challenges these students face;

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has adopted the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children at 105 ILCS 5/27A-1 et seq., and the Illinois State Board of Education has established the Purple Star Designation pursuant to House Joint Resolution 10 of the 102nd General Assembly to recognize schools that demonstrate a major commitment to supporting military-connected students and their families;

WHEREAS, United Township High School maintains a designated staff point of contact, has completed staff professional development on the needs of military-connected students, provides a dedicated information resource for military families, operates a student-led transition program through Link Crew, and conducts ongoing supportive activities including an annual Veterans Day recognition program, a permanent public military display, and the recognition at commencement of graduating seniors entering military service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of United Township High School District 30, Rock Island and Henry Counties, Illinois, that the District is committed to providing a welcoming, supportive, and academically responsive environment for all military-connected students and their families.
