RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BEEVILLE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE FOR THE CALLED MAY 12, 2012 SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION IN SUB-DISTRICT II PURSUANT TO THE PROVISION IN SECTION 2.053 OF THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE.

WHERE AS, there came to be acknowledged that the incumbent for the May 12, 2012 School Board Election for Sub-District I is unopposed, and

WHERE AS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.052 of the Texas Election code the Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the Beeville Independent School District, as “the authority responsible for having the official Ballot prepared”, presented to the Board of Trustees during their regular meeting on April 10, 2012, a certification certifying that the incumbent, Velma Elizalde for Sub-District II is unopposed, and

WHERE AS, in the same certification the secretary of the Board of Trustees further certifies that no candidates are to be placed on a list of write-in candidates.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Beeville Independent School District in Beeville, Texas, that pursuant to the Texas Election Code Section 2.053 “Unopposed incumbent Velma Elizalde for Sub-District II is hereby declared elected for a three year term of office, effective May 12, 2012 the expiration date of the current term.
