K-2 Classroom: JoAnn Powell

Babb Elementary had 100% Parent Teacher Conferences in November. We also had a great turnout for our Family Thanksgiving Dinner/Lunch. Parents and Guardians sure enjoyed eating lunch with their child/children to celebrate Thanksgiving.

K-6 Began practice for their annual Christmas Play. Students got their parts and are practicing their songs. We had our first attendance incentive on Friday, November 17, 2023.
