District Improvement Planning

Any district that has a school in improvement status is required to submit a District Improvement Plan to the SDE. Homedale Middle School has "Continuous Improvement" status so HSD had to update the improvement plan within the WISE tool. I've included a summary of the plan with updates and target completion dates.

ISEE Phase II B Grant

Using ISEE grant funds Homedale hosted a workshop on Discovery Education on Saturday, February 28. Kim Miller, a teacher who has done training for us before, led a dozen Marsing and Homedale teachers through resources for using digital media in teaching.

Using ISEE grant funds we are also able to offer an additional training to teachers on Assessment for Learning. This training originally occurred on February 12. After hearing such positive feedback from the teachers who attended the first training we have been able to schedule another session for March 17. This second opportunity will allow each district in the consortium to send an additional 16 teachers.

We are certainly thankful for the support this grant has provided our teachers and administrators.
