An act relating to elections; providing for the time of elections and taking office in the city of Duluth and Independent School District No. 709, Duluth.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. DULUTH, CITY OF, AND INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 709; ELECTION OF OFFICERS. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1971, Chapter 123, or any other general or special law to the contrary, all elected officers in the city of Duluth, including city council members, mayor, municipal judges and board members of independent school district No. 709, Duluth, shall be elected pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapters 200 to 211, at a general election to be held on the uniform municipal election day established by Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 205.20, Subdivision 2. Said officers shall be nominated at a primary election to be held on a date designated by the city council of the city of Duluth, which date shall be not less than 14 days before the general election. The newly elected

officers shall take office on the first Monday in January following their elections. The terms of the incumbents shall be extended to conform to the changes prescribed by this act.

Sec. 2. The first elections pursuant to section 1 shall be in 1975.
