Background Information

The top priority of Midway ISD and the State of Texas is keeping students and staff safe every day. The Intruder Detection Audit process is designed to evaluate the safety and security of campuses based on a set of physical and procedural criteria, developed in coordination with the Texas School Safety Center as required by TEC, §37.1084. The Texas Education Agency contracts with the Regional Educational Service Centers to conduct Intruder Detection Audits. The ESC inspectors utilize a rubric that is divided into phases and the results of the audits are reported back to the district and TEA.

We acknowledge that parents and community members are likely very interested in the details of the audit results; however, it is in the best interest of the students that we do not share this information with the broader public as it could lead to compromising important campus security information. Specific details of the IDA can be discussed in closed session and will be discussed with the MISD Safety and Security Committee at our next meeting on March 20, 2025. Midway ISD is committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for our students and staff.
