Positives:

This year the staff at Big Sky & Glendale Schools have pulled together to support the teacher shortage at Big Sky School. Ms. Nancy Light has taken on an overload of students (29 students to 1 teacher in a multigrade classroom) and Mrs. Ellen Christoferson the paraprofessional has diligently supported at both Big Sky (mornings) & Glendale Schools (afternoons) to ease the overload issue. Ms. Show has shown great flexibility in sharing Mrs. Christoferson's duties with Big Sky School and has also made adjustments to support her 15 student load in her multigrade classroom.

Needs/Concerns:

A great concern for both the Glendale & Big Sky Schools is teacher & staff recruitment at the Big Sky School for the 22-23 school year. It is difficult to find a classroom teacher to support rural schools in Montana, however the uniqueness of the Big Sky School (distance from Cut Bank or Browning, multigrade, high number of students) makes it a greater challenge to recruit and retain high-quality not just one, but two educators.
