ACTION: APPROVAL OF KISD NATATORIUM CONTRACT -

NATIONAL MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS SOCIETY

In partnership with the North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, the KISD Natatorium will extend its rehabilitation and water therapy classes for the forty-two week period of Monday, August 9, 2004 through May 27, 2005.

The Keller ISD Natatorium and the MS Chapter have successfully worked together, providing water therapy classes since October 2003. The success and participation in this program continues to be overwhelmingly positive Effective October 4, MS will add an additional weekly Friday class to the calendar, increasing both availability and access to patients throughout North Central Texas.

The contract between the North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society and Keller ISD is attached. The contract agreement has been approved as to form by our legal counsel.

The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society Contract as presented.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Whereas, North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society has requested and received permission from the Keller Independent School District to use the KISD Natatorium beginning Monday, August 9, 2004 to May 27, 2005 (42 Weeks) for the purpose of conducting rehabilitation and water therapy classes. Proof of Liability Insurance with Keller ISD as a named insured will be provided by North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. This insurance policy will remain in force during the full term of this agreement. KISD must be notified prior to any changes in carrier or coverage and all activities by North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society at the KISD Natatorium will be suspended until adequate coverage is obtained.

Any other activities not mentioned in this agreed contract period or contract amount must have KISD approval prior to use and will be charged at the prevailing KISD Natatorium rates.

The party who signs this contract as representative of the requesting organization agrees that the organization will underwrite any damage due to the use of the premises by the organization and that the activities that will be conducted on the premises are lawful and in accordance with state and federal law as it pertains to conduct on school district facilities in the State of Texas.

II. PROHIBITED PRACTICES

The following matters are to be considered as prohibited practices and are not to be indulged in by the requesting organization:

- 1. **Use of intoxicants and/or tobacco products** is a violation of State Law;
- 2. **No firearms are allowed in the Natatorium** as provided by Texas State Law;

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- 3. **No signs**, posters or billboards **will be posted** on walls, stands, or allowed in the KISD Natatorium;
- 4. **No**additions to, or **changes of**, existing **facilities** shall be made without the written approval of Keller ISD;
- 5. The **use** of the Natatorium **may not be assigned to a third party**, without the prior <u>written</u> approval of the Keller ISD;
- 6. The **issuance of keys** to parties other than District personnel directly responsible for the facility is specifically prohibited. **NO EXCEPTIONS** shall be made;
- 7. **Use of the facility without** the full-time presence of **a custodian** is prohibited. Custodians are to be on duty during the full range of activities. They <u>cannot</u> open the facility, leave the premises and return later to clean;
- 8. **No entertainment** may be provided that may be **detrimental to community welfare**, in violation of the code of conduct allowed by Keller ISD or destructive to the buildings, fixtures or furniture; and
- 9. **No meeting** will be held in the school building **for the purpose of** advancing **any doctrine subversive to the Constitution** and laws of the State of Texas, or the United States of America.
- 10. No glass containers will be allowed in the facility; and
- 11. No bull horns or other loud sound-emitting devices shall be allowed in the Natatorium.
- 12. Use of diving boards during class is prohibited and may only be used under direct supervision by Certified Diving Coaches and written approval of the Keller ISD Natatorium Manager.

III. AGREEMENT

I assume, for North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society all responsibility for the use and care of all property placed in our charge, or used by us, and agree to pay for all damages or losses occurring during our occupancy, including leaving the facility in good order, or North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society will pay for additional cleaning and/or repairs.

The "NO SMOKING" regulations will be observed in all School District facilities. Furthermore, I am aware that arrangements for the use of equipment such as PA systems, timing systems, etc., must be made with the staff in writing.

Either party may terminate this agreement by giving the other party at least thirty (30) days notice in writing. If this agreement is terminated early, then **North Central Texas Chapter of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society** shall be entitled to a prorate reimbursement for the unused portion of the payment made in advance.

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All parties signing this agreement have been duly authorized by the organization they are representing to sign this agreement with the provisions herein stated.
