DESCRIPTION:

BHM Policy 524 Internet Responsible Use to include the following statement:

"The school district will educate students about appropriate online behavior, including interacting with other individuals on social networking websites and in chat rooms and cyber bullying awareness and response."

The proposed curriculum lessons were presented at the October 8, 2012 school board workshop.

The elementary curriculum lessons will be taught by each classroom teacher as a part of the health curriculum. These lessons have been mapped in the Atlas curriculum management software and a copy of the unit maps are attached.

The BCMS curriculum lessons will be taught by each Prime Time teacher as a part of the curriculum. These lessons are in the process of being articulated and mapped to the Atlas system.

BHS Responsible Use curriculum is still in development and will be brought for review once it is finalized.
