<p><b>Goal 1:</b> 80% of staff will use essential standards to drive instruction by the end of 2024-2025 school year.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Guest speakers from Marzano led sessions during our February 10th In-Service Day, working with all district teachers on standards-based learning.</li><li>● Next steps will involve reassessing Essential Standards using feedback gathered from the February 10th In-service.</li></ul>
<p><b>Goal 2:</b> By 2028-29 create district benchmark assessments for essential standards</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Gradebook alignment has been incorporated into the regulation addressing student grading and standards-based grading.</li><li>● Benchmarks will be addressed once learning progressions and proficiency scales are completed, based on the updated essential standards</li></ul>
<p><b>Goal 3:</b> 2024-2025 develop a process/program to bolster induction and support of new hires</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Substitute observation checklists are completed for each job category, next steps implementation</li><li>● Currently in development is a support group designed to provide professional development and foster collaboration among Assistant Principals</li></ul>
