In accordance with Board Policy CV, attached for your review is the written cost estimate of the proposed change order to sealed proposal 181905 on Locker Room Improvements for Eagle Pass High School and C.C. Winn Campuses submitted to us by Mr. Davis Powell, Architect of Record for the district. As required by board policy CV (Local), a change order valued at or above \$50,000 requires Board approval.

#### **FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION**

CV (LEGAL)

"Company" means a for-profit sole proprietorship, organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those entities or business associations that exists to make a profit. Gov't Code 808.001(2)

#### **Change Orders**

If a change in plans or specifications is necessary after the performance of a contract is begun or if it is necessary to decrease or increase the quantity of work to be performed or of materials, equipment, or supplies to be furnished, the district may approve change orders making the changes. The district may grant general authority to an administrative official to approve the change orders.

The total contract price may not be increased because of the changes unless additional money for increased costs is approved for that purpose from available money or is provided for by the authorization of the issuance of time warrants.

A contract with an original contract price of \$1 million or more may not be increased by more than 25 percent. If a change order for a contract with an original contract price of less than \$1 million increases the contract amount to \$1 million or more, the total of the subsequent change orders may not increase the revised contract amount by more than 25 percent of the original contract price.

#### Education Code 44.0411

#### Inspection, Verification, and Testing

Independently of the contractor, construction manager-at-risk, or design-build firm, a district shall provide or contract for the construction materials engineering, testing, and inspection services and the verification testing services necessary for acceptance of the facility by the district. The district shall select the services for which it contracts in accordance with Government Code 2254.004. *Gov't Code 2269.058* 

#### **Impact Fees**

A district is not required to pay impact fees imposed under Local Government Code Chapter 395 unless the board consents to the payment of the fees by entering a contract with the political subdivision that imposes the fees. The contract may contain terms the board considers advisable to provide for the payment of the fees. *Local Gov't Code 395.022* 

#### Energy Savings Performance Contracts

The contracting and delivery procedures for construction projects described at Government Code Chapter 2269 do not apply to energy savings performance contracts described at Education Code 44.901. *Education Code 44.901(j)* [See CL]

#### Compliance with Law

The Superintendent shall establish procedures that ensure that all school facilities within the District comply with applicable laws and local building codes.

# Construction Contracts

Prior to advertising, the Board shall determine the project delivery/contract award method to be used for each construction contract valued at or above \$50,000. To assist the Board, the Superintendent shall recommend the project delivery/contract award method that he or she determines provides the best value to the District. [See CV series]

For construction contracts valued at or above \$50,000, the Superintendent shall also submit the resulting contract to the Board for approval. Lesser expenditures for construction and constructionrelated materials or services shall be at the discretion of the Superintendent and consistent with law and policy. [See also CH]

#### **Initial Phase**

Bidding for District construction projects for which the architect is contracted shall be handled by the architect, who will be responsible for receiving and recording all bonds, deposits, and other documents as required. Performance and pay bonds in the amount of the estimated cost of the project shall be required before contracts for construction are signed.

#### **Change Orders**

Change orders permitted by law shall be approved prior to any changes being made in the approved plans or the actual construction of the facility.

Change orders valued at or above \$50,000 shall require Board approval. The Superintendent shall be authorized to approve change orders of a lesser amount.

In all change orders, the District's architect shall give a written cost estimate of the proposed change and submit it to the administration. The signature of the Superintendent or designee shall be required before a change order may be executed.

#### **Emergency**

When emergencies arise that require an immediate response, the architect may issue a field order when the amount in question is not over \$1,000. However, a cost estimate shall be submitted and verbal approval given by the Superintendent or designee before proceeding. The field order shall then be followed by a written change order as indicated above.


# Project Administration

Eagle Pass High School and CC Winn Campuses Change Order #1 Recommendation Revised

Dear Mr. Gonzalez,

We are requesting your consideration of the following Change Order for the Eagle Pass High School and CC Winn Campus Locker Room Remodel.

The proposed change order includes three significant improvements that were requested by the administrators of each campus. First, locker areas are being added for the dance and cheer teams at both campuses. This is reflected in \$25,274.70 Proposal Request #2.

Secondly, the change order will add 6 showers and a new AC and ventilation system in the new girl's locker area of EPHS. Two new showers will also be added in the girl's PE area of CC Winn. This is reflected in the \$69,063.62 Proposal Request #3.

Thirdly, A request has been made for the locker room at Eagle Pass High School to include chain ink divider's separating the locker areas to minimize the potential for crime. This is reflected in the \$16,225.00 for Proposal Request #4.

We have reviewed these proposals and consider them reasonable for the scope of work required.
