The Coppel ISD Board of Trustees and Superintendent Brad Hunt designated a Legislative Subcommittee to discuss and draft the district's Legislative Priorities/Agenda for the 86th Legislative session. The members of this committee consist of:

This subcommittee met three times to draft the Coppel ISD Legislative Priorities/Agenda for the 86th Texas Legislative Session, which are derived from inclusive conversation among the subcommittee members. Additionally, these legislative priorities are aligned with peer districts and state associations and organizations, such as the Texas Association of School Administrators (TASA) and the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB).
