SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSED REVISION TO EHDC (LOCAL): ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR EARNING CREDIT; CREDIT BY EXAMINATION WITHOUT PRIOR INSTRUCTION

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the proposed change to DHDC (LOCAL) Policy, effective for

all students begin the 2025-2026 school year. This adjustment will maintain high academic standards, safeguard instructional quality, and ensure efficient use of district resources. to recommend a revision to the District's Credit by Examination (CBE) policy regarding acceleration for a full grade level. A student shall be permitted only one attempt to

accelerate within a specific grade level.

RATIONALE: 1. Academic Consistency – Limiting the number of attempts ensures that students who pursue full-grade acceleration are fully prepared academically and developmentally before testing.

- 2. Instructional Continuity This policy minimizes repeated disruptions to instructional planning and student placement.
- 3. Resource Management Credit by Examination administration requires significant staff time and materials. Restricting attempts reduces unnecessary retesting and allows resources to be directed toward students most ready for acceleration.
- 4. Alignment with Best Practices State guidelines and peer district policies support limiting multiple attempts for full-grade acceleration to maintain rigor and integrity in the process.
