### ADOPT 2017-18 BUDGET

Stephen Lowry made a motion to adopt the budget for general fund, food service fund and debt service for the 2016-17 school year as presented by the administration. The total budget is \$45,985,000. Chris McCurley seconded the motion.

### ADOPT ORDINANCE TO SET TAX RATE FOR 2017-18

A motion was made by Stephen Lowry to adopt ordinance to set the tax rate for 2017-18 at \$1.125, to be assessed and collected as follows: \$ 1.04 for maintenance and operation and \$0.085 for principal and interest on debts. Chris McCurley seconded the motion.

#### ORDINANCE TO SET TAX RATE

Date: August 28, 2017

On this date, we, the Board of Trustees of the Wylie Independent School District, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2017-18 at a total tax rate of \$1.125, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:

- \$ 1.04 for the purpose of maintenance and operation, and
- \$ 0.085 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts.

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the District.
