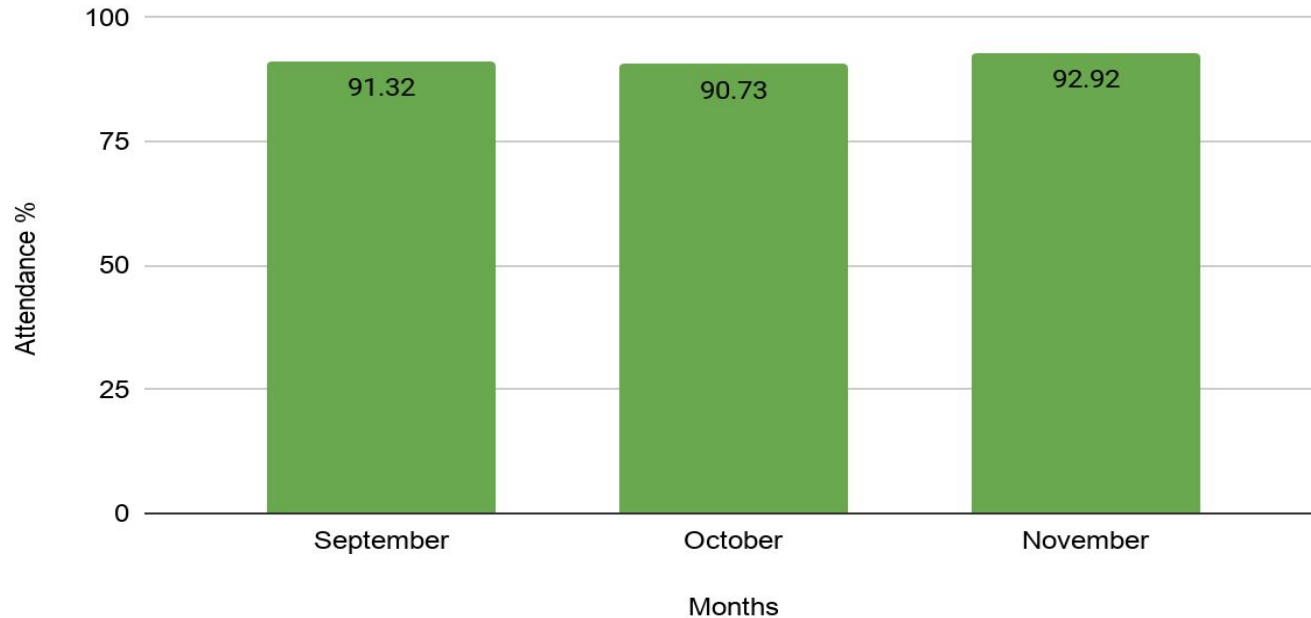

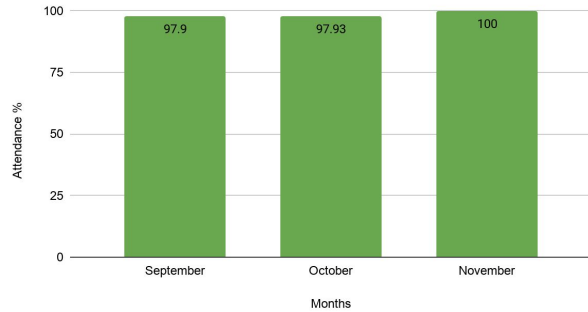

## Fall Attendance School Wide



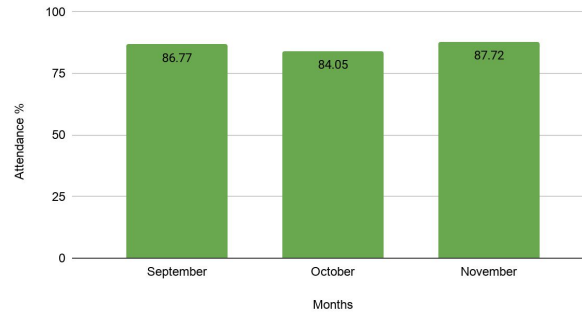
## NOVEMBER ATTENDANCE FOR PRE-K + KINDER + 1ST GRADE

Fall PK Attendance



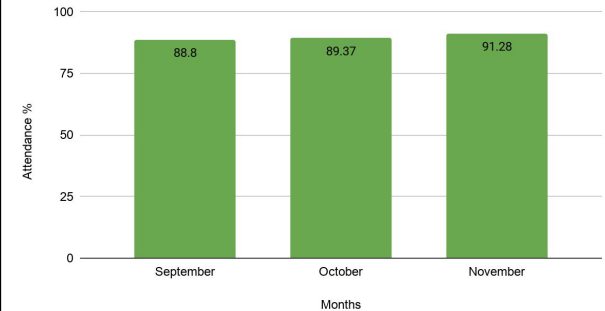
**Pre-Kindergarten** attendance is at **100%** for November

Kindergarten



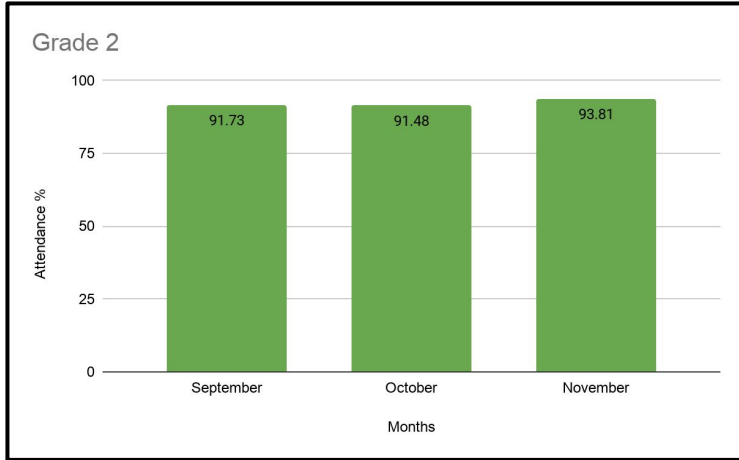
**Kindergarten** attendance is at **88%** for November

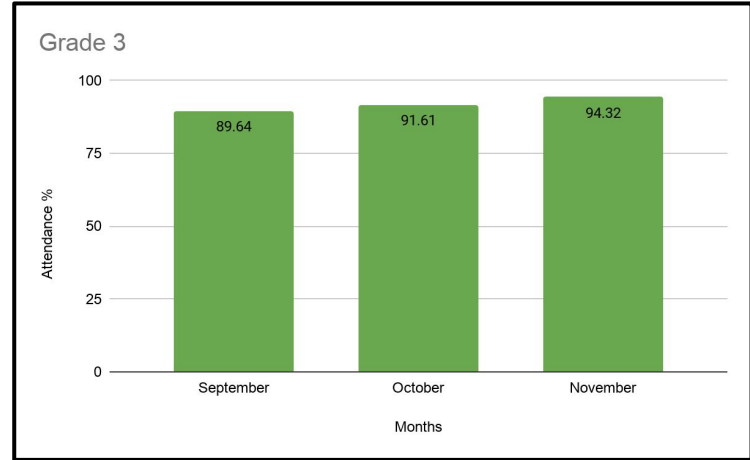


**1st Grade** attendance is at **91%** for November

## NOVEMBER ATTENDANCE FOR 2ND GRADE + 3RD GRADE

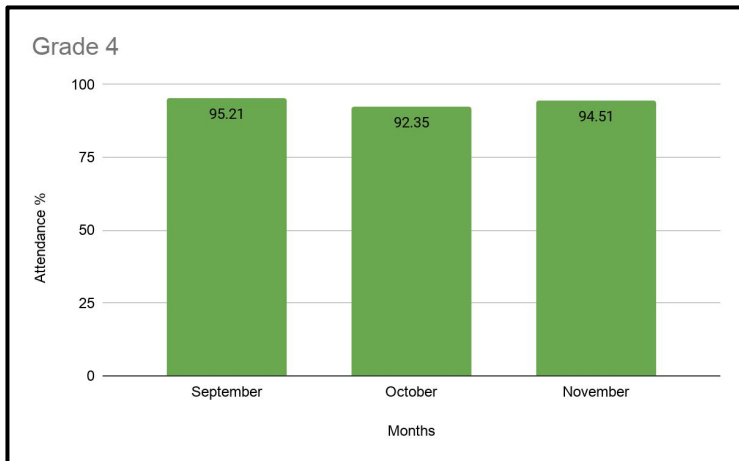


**2nd Grade** attendance is at **94%** for November

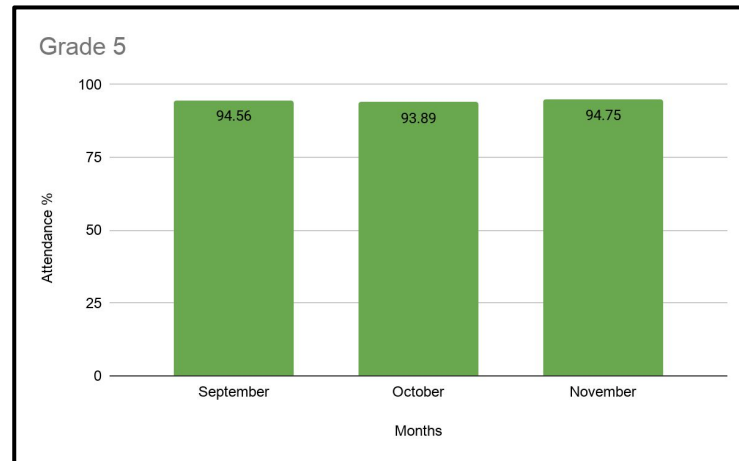


**3rd Grade** attendance is at **94%** for November

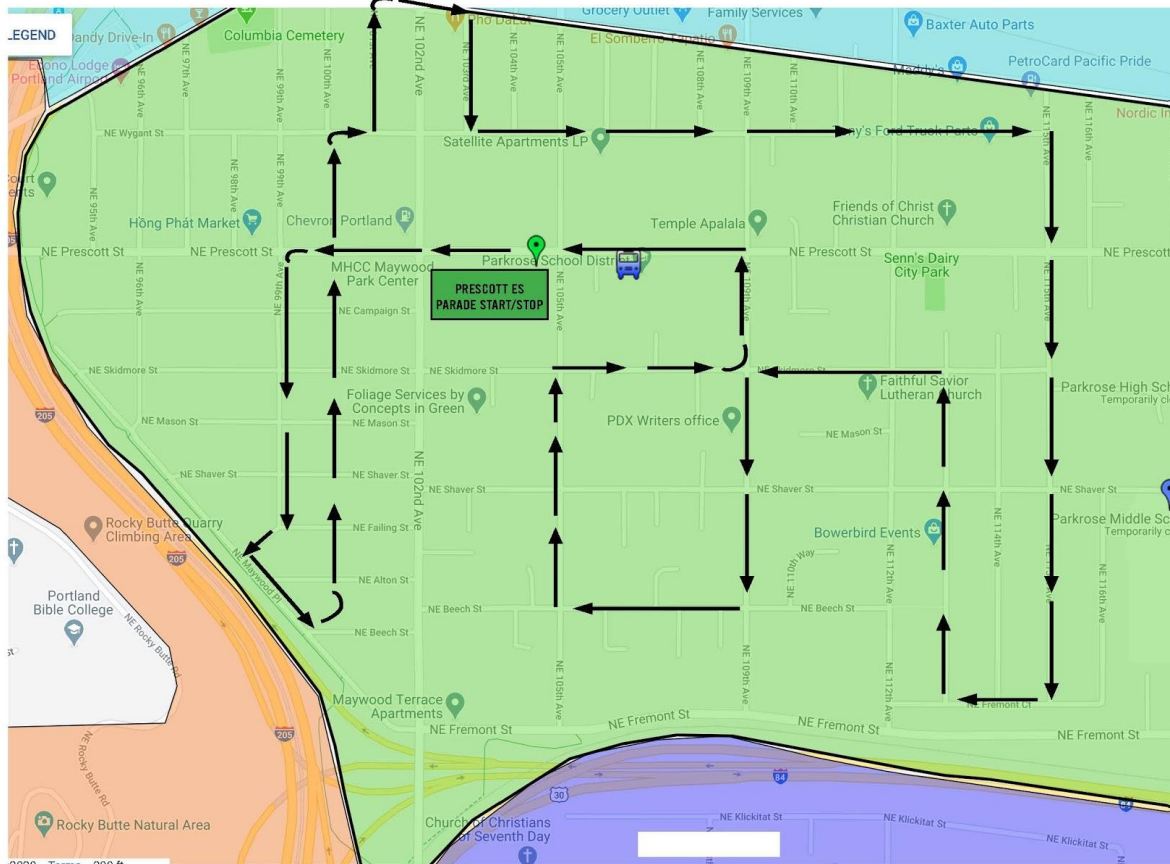

Turn **RIGHT** and head **EAST** on **Wygant Street**

Turn **LEFT** and head **NORTH** on 101st Street

Turn **RIGHT** and head **EAST** down Sandy Street

Turn **RIGHT** and head **SOUTH** down 103rd Street

Turn **RIGHT** and head **EAST** on Wygant Street

Turn **RIGHT** and head **SOUTH** on 115th Avenue

Turn **RIGHT** and head **WEST** on Fremont Street

Turn **RIGHT** and head **NORTH** on 113th Street

Turn **LEFT** and head **WEST** on Skidmore Street

Turn **LEFT** and head **SOUTH** on 109th Avenue

Turn **RIGHT** and head **WEST** on Beech Street

Turn **RIGHT** and head **NORTH** on 105th Avenue

Turn **RIGHT** and head **EAST** on Skidmore Street

Turn **LEFT** and head **NORTH** on 109th Street

Turn **LEFT** and head **WEST** back to Prescott ES

## COVID-19 Testing and Research

- SEI, in partnership with OHSU, is testing individuals age 2 and older in your neighborhood on a voluntary basis for COVID-19
- You do not need to have symptoms to receive testing
- If you are interested, you can sign up for a new research study. Sign up is voluntary and you do NOT need to sign up to receive clinical COVID-19 testing



### OPTIONAL RESEARCH SUMMARY

- This testing is related to research on new methods to test for COVID-19 in saliva or nasopharyngeal swabs and to test for COVID-19 signals found within sewage in your neighborhood. The purpose of the study is to test if sewage can screen many people at one time to detect COVID-19 in the community and to compare how effective sewage testing is as compared to weekly saliva testing.
- We will also ask if you would like to fill out a questionnaire and let us save your sample for future research on COVID-19

## Lunch Bunch

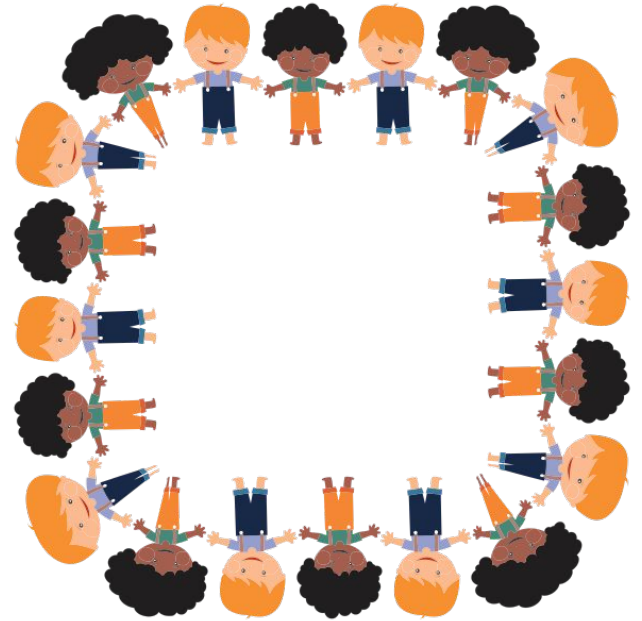
Counselor Megan hosts a daily hour-long social Zoom for students to eat lunch and chat about various topics

## Zoom Clubs

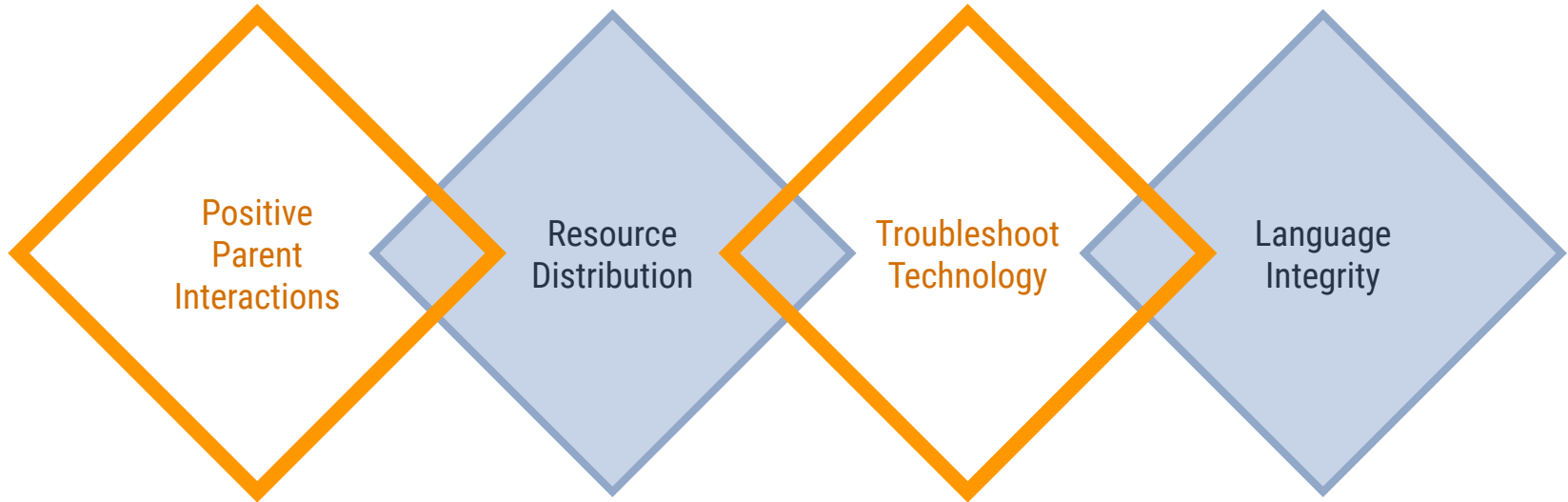
Counselor Megan is working with several students on creating Zoom Clubs for students to gather in affinity spaces

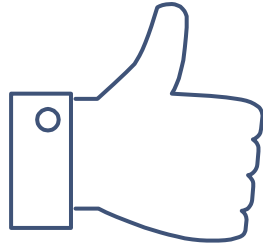
