Good afternoon,

I know some of you don't officially start until Monday but I need to make sure this item gets added to both school board meetings in July.

Back in August 2023, the Gator Clay Busters Trap Shooting team went to the joint sports board and asked to be apart of it for both schools to cover the MSHSL Tournament expenses (hotels and transportation) if we should send any individuals/teams to the tournament. After talking with Dan in June, it was supposed to then go to both school boards for a vote but that piece didn't happen and I was unaware that it needed to happen, otherwise this would have been done last year.

So in June, when we had a team qualify for MSHSL state tournament and I asked for both schools to cover hotel rooms and transportation, that couldn't be done due to this missing school board piece that we were unaware didn't happen. Badger did provide a van and paid for the fuel for the tournament this year....thank you!!!

So we need both school boards to vote if Gator Clay Busters can be apart of the joint sports board (the joint sports board had agreed last august this should be done) for the MSHSL tournament and expenses are paid from both schools at the July meeting. Dan and I also talked about getting reimbursement for this past June for our hotel rooms. I do have a receipt for that to turn in if that is agreed to as well. That total cost for 4 rooms (2 student rooms and 2 coaches rooms) for 1 night was \$362.17 to be split by both schools and paid to Gator Clay Busters.

Moving forward, the costs that we would ask to be covered are transportation, hotel rooms, and registration fees (currently that is \$225 for team and \$45 per individual...those could change in the future). Gator Clay Busters covered the registration fee this year and not requesting reimbursement for that but moving forward, if that fee could be covered as well, we would appreciate it! Depending on how many qualify for MSHSL state, it should be less than \$1000 total or \$500 from each school.

Please let me know if you have any questions. Dan can also fill in any gaps as well since he was at the August sports board meeting last year and is aware this item needs to get done in July.
